

## IMPACT OF PE & SPORTS PREMIUM FUNDING 2015-16

### Introduction what is the Sports Premium?

Schools receive PE and sport premium funding based on the number of pupils in years 1 to 6. In most cases, the DFE determine how many pupils in your school attract the funding using data from the January school census. The funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. The money can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools. Purpose of the funding Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

### Funding for 2015 to 2016

- Schools with 16 or fewer eligible pupils receive £500 per pupil.
- Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils receive £8,000 and an additional payment of £5 per pupil.
